MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

MYANMAR ENGINEERING COUNCIL (MEngC)

and

INSTITUTE OF ENGINEERING EDUCATION TAIWAN (IEET)

Whereas:

- (A) MEngC acknowledges its commitment to enhancing the quality of engineering education and has experience in engineering accreditation system in Myanmar;
- (B) IEET acknowledges its commitment to enhancing the quality of engineering education and has experience in engineering accreditation system in Taiwan;
- (C) MEngC and IEET share an interest in promoting quality assurance in engineering education worldwide;
- (D) MEngC and IEET are both committed to the quality assurance in professional assessment of engineers.
- (E) MEngC and IEET are interested in promoting cooperation between the two organizations in Myanmar and Taiwan:

MEngC and IEET agree to collaborate in matters related to engineering education, accreditation activities, and professional assessment. To establish linkages for cooperation, they agree to:

- 1. Develop procedures to facilitate the exchange of representatives to observe the accreditation activities of both MEngC and IEET;
- Collaborate in the development of workshops to promote principles and practices to address current needs of either party for the benefit of promoting development of accreditation of engineering education and professional assessment:
- 3. Develop substantially equivalency in accreditation system under the Federation of Engineering Institutions of Asia and Pacific (FEIAP) and the International Engineering Alliance (IEA) based on collaboration, information and document exchange, and review of each other's accreditation procedures;
- 4. Negotiate and mutually agree upon any expenses associated with the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding prior to the execution of any projects or services.

This agreement is valid effective the day it is signed and may be revised through mutual agreement of both parties or terminated by either party upon six months written notice.
